After the celebration of Pentecost the Church enters into a long period known as Ordinary Time which continues until Advent comes round and a time we have already encountered during shorter period of Ordinary Time between Christmas and Lent.

So what is the meaning behind Ordinary Time? It certainly does not mean a season of dull routines. What it provides is the time to get to know the person Jesus Christ through the gospel readings we will listen to during the Sundays ahead. We encounter the mission of Jesus, his call to us to be his followers and witnesses and encouragement to find the presence of Jesus in our daily lives through prayerful reflection of the gospel readings.

Ordinary Time provides opportunities for us to grow into who we are called to be by imitating the lived reality of Jesus.

Got questions about life? Alpha sessions freely explore the basics of the Christian faith and are designed to create conversations.

Solemnities and Feasts Ahead

St Aloysius Gonzaga: A 16th cent Jesuit who died while caring for people suffering from a deadly plague while in Rome.

St John Fisher and St Thomas More: Both opposed Henry VII 's opposition of the Catholic Church's teaching on marriage and his desire for a divorce in order to marry Ann Bolyne. John Fisher was the Bishop of Rochester and Thomas More the Lord Chancellor at the time of their opposition to Henry VIII. Both were martyred for their faith.

Nativity of St John the Baptist: Celebrating the birth of John the Baptist who was to be the herald for Jesus Christ.

Our Lady of Perpetual Succour: Patron of the Diocese of Hallam and intercessor for us all to her Son, Jesus Christ.

St Irenaeus: Greek bishop who helped to extend the Christian communities on southern France and became Bishop of Lyon. He was martyred for his faith in 202 AD.
