

Diocesan Jubilee Celebrations in November - Jubilee of Volunteers - The parish of the Immaculate Conception has been asked to host a diocesan Mass of Thanksgiving on Saturday 15th November 11am for all who voluntarily gift their time and charisms to serve others in need. This is an invitation to everyone who volunteer their time either within the two parishes or in the local community in service of others. Obvious examples will be the work of the SVP, taking Communion to the housebound, running a young person's sports group and includes those hidden tasks, flower arranging, cleaning, popping round to a neighbour. This morning's liturgy gives a chance to bless and give thanksgiving for their work. We also need volunteers (including cake Faries) from both the Immaculate Conception and St Gerard's to welcome people and provide refreshments afterwards.

#### Feasts and Saints

Saints Simon and Jude (28th October): Two of Jesus' twelve apostles who are traditionally believed to have preached the gospel together in Persia and were martyred in Syria. Simon is identified as the 'Zealot' or the 'Canaanite' distinguishing him from Peter, while Jude us also known as Thaddeus and is especially known as the patron of hopeless causes.

All Saints (2nd November): A Christian Commemoration of all saints, both known and unknown. Saints are recognised as models of holiness and inspirations for people to follow in witness.

All Souls (3rd November): We pray for the Souls in Purgatory who are being purified before entering heaven. The Mass is the central liturgical act, where the faithful on earth can offer prayers, alms, and sacrifices like the Holy Mass to assist the souls in purgatory.

Saint Charles Borromeo (4th November): St Charles lived during a period of reform within the Catholic Church. He worked behind the scenes to ensure that the Council of Trent was completed. He worked towards establishing a better formation of seminarians and as Archbishop of Milan set out to feed 60,000 to 70,000 people a day during the plague and famine of 1576. St Charles saw Christ in his neighbour living by the words found in Matthew 25:35-36. Charity done for the least of his people was charity done to Christ.

Dedication of the Lateran Basilica (5th November): Celebrated by the Universal Church, this is a commemoration of the consecration of the Lateran Basilica. The basilica is seen as the mother and head of all churches in the City and the World, signifying its status as the highest ranking church in the Catholic Church and a symbol of unity. The feast was extended worldwide in 1726 to promote universal Catholic unity.
