Feasts and Saints

St Andrew Dung Lac and Companions (24th November): Andrew Dung Lac is one of 117 people martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. It is worth reflecting that the Church in Vietnam has continually been under persecution right into the present century and yet 7 million Catholics, that is just under 8% of the population, remain faithful to their faith which is proving to be hardier than the forces that will to destroy it.

St Francis Xavier (3rd December): He was one of the founders of the Jesuit Order under the leadership of St Ignatius of Loyola. In 1540 with only 48 hours' notice, St Francis Xavier stepped into replace another Jesuit who had become too ill to make the journey to bring Christianity to parts of India and beyond including China and Japan. As his work progressed he became more receptive to the diverse cultures he had encountered and more aware of the richness of God's presence in all things and all people. He never returned to Europe and died on Sancian Island near Canton on December 3rd 52. He was 46 years old.
