Feasts and Saints

Our Lady of Guadalupe (12th December): Our Lady of Guadalupe is a title given to Our Lady in Mexico after her appearance to an indigenous man named Juan Diego in December 1531. She asked Juan to instruct the local bishop to build a shrine to her on Tepeyac Hill near modern Mexico City. When the bishop asked Juan for a sign, Our Lady instructed Juan to gather roses from the hill top, roses were unusual in Mexico during December, and when he presented them to the bishop they had miraculously arranged in the form of the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe heavily pregnant, on the fabric of Juan's cloak.
