Solemnities

St John Fisher & St Thomas More: St John Fisher was one of King Henry VIII's most admired bishops, until he became the only English bishop who refused to deny the legality of the Kings first marriage to Catherine of Aragon. St Thomas More was a father of four who became Lord Chancellor of England. He also refused to give support to King Henry VIII's desire to dissolve his first marriage. Both men were beheaded on Tower Hill.

The Nativity of St John the Baptist: This feast comes three months after the Annunciation and is one of the oldest festivals of the Church.

Our Lady of Perpetual Succour: Devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Succour encourages the faithful to ask Our Lady to intercede for us and ask for her Son's compassion and mercy on our behalf. Our Lady of Perpetual Succour is the Patron of our diocese of Hallam.

St Thomas, Apostle: One of the twelve apostles of Christ. Tradition tells us that he took the message of the Gospel to communities in India, in particular, modern day Kerela.
