Solemnities & Feast Days

St Mary Magdalene (22nd July); Travelled with Jesus on his public ministry and witnessed his death and resurrection.

St Bridget of Sweeden (23rd July); Born in 1304 Bridget was married to Ulf Gudmarsson and had eight children. After his death she founded of the Bridgettines and became a Catholic mystic. She is one of six patrons of Europe.

Blessed Nicolas Garlick & Robert Ludlum (24th); Both were priests caught and arrested at Padley Mannor on the 12th July 1588. They were found guilty of treason and hung, drawn and quartered in Derby on the 24th of July.

St James (25th July); One of the twelve apostles of Jesus Christ and the first to be martyred. Tradition says that his remains rest in Santiago de Compostella.

St Martha, Mary & Lazarus (29th July); Two sisters and a brother who were close friends of Jesus. St Martha is known for her active life, St Mary as a contemplative and St Lazarus was raised from the dead by Jesus.

St Ignatius (31st July); Ignatius of Loyola lived in the 16th cent. Founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and developed spiritual exercises known today as Ignatian spirituality.

St Alphonsus Mary de' Liguori (1st August); An 18th cent Catholic bishop, spiritual writer, scholastic philosopher and theologian. Founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists)
